2025 Survey Results and Action Plans

Dear Clients and Carers,

Thank you for taking the time to complete our 2025 Surveys. Your feedback is invaluable in helping us grow and continuously improve our services at Christies Care.

We are delighted to hear that so many clients have had positive experiences. These are a few key results we are exceptionally proud of:

- 91% scored 8 or above for carer satisfaction.
- 86% scored 8 or above, saying carers' training enabled them to meet their needs.
- 91% scored 8 or above for feeling safe living independently at home with the support of our carers.
- 91% scored 8 or above for quality of care.

You also shared where we can improve, and we want to assure you that we have taken all concerns seriously.

You Said: You would like a Birdie messaging facility so families can engage with care notes.

We are currently working with Birdie to understand what communication features are possible and how we could introduce them.

You Said: Communication needs to be more consistent.

We're reviewing our communication channels and implementing clearer standards to ensure timely and consistent communication.

You Said: You would like more advance notice of carer changes.

We are improving our scheduling processes to reduce last-minute changes and provide earlier notifications whenever possible.

You Said: More person-centred dementia training is needed.

We are expanding our dementia training programme to ensure all carers receive comprehensive, person-centred dementia education.

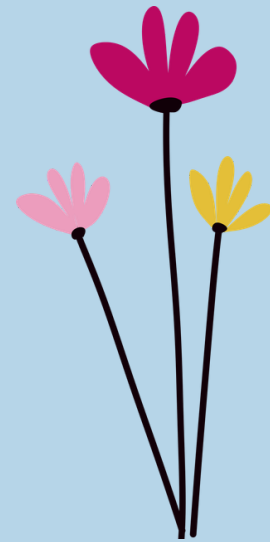

Important Reminder: Do Not Lift Clients After a Fall

We have recently seen a rise in incidents where clients have been lifted after a fall. We want to remind all Carers that it is vital never to lift a client who has fallen. Following this guidance is essential for safe practice and safeguarding, protecting both you and the client

Why you must not lift a fallen client?

Serious Risk of Injury to Carers

Manual handling guidance clearly states that catching or lifting a client especially unexpectedly places you at high risk of musculoskeletal injury. Even well-intentioned lifting can result in significant harm.

Potential to Cause Further Harm to the Client

Falls may involve fractures, spinal injury, or head trauma to the client, which are not always obvious at first. Lifting a client up could worsen hidden injuries or cause additional harm.

What to do instead?

- 1 Keep the Client Calm, Comfortable and Reassured**
Check the area for hazards, reassure and assess the client, and make them comfortable.
- 2 If the client is unable to get up independently**
Attempt the two chair method and if the client is unable to do this, call 999 or press the pendant alarm.
- 3 Report the Incident**
Document the fall on Birdie and update the office with any developments.

Talk about the perfect Christies Care meet cute.

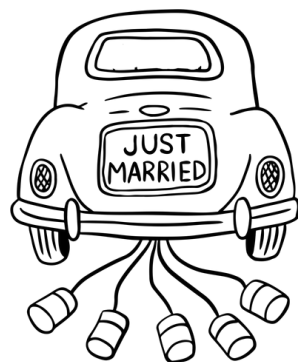
In 2024, Chloe and Karen met during their update training. Just 2 days, and that was all it took. They knew they had met someone special.

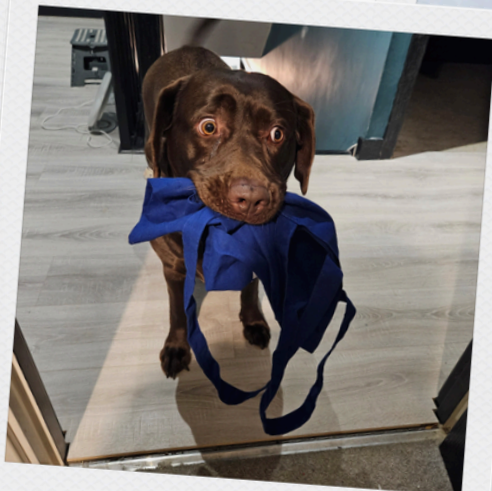
